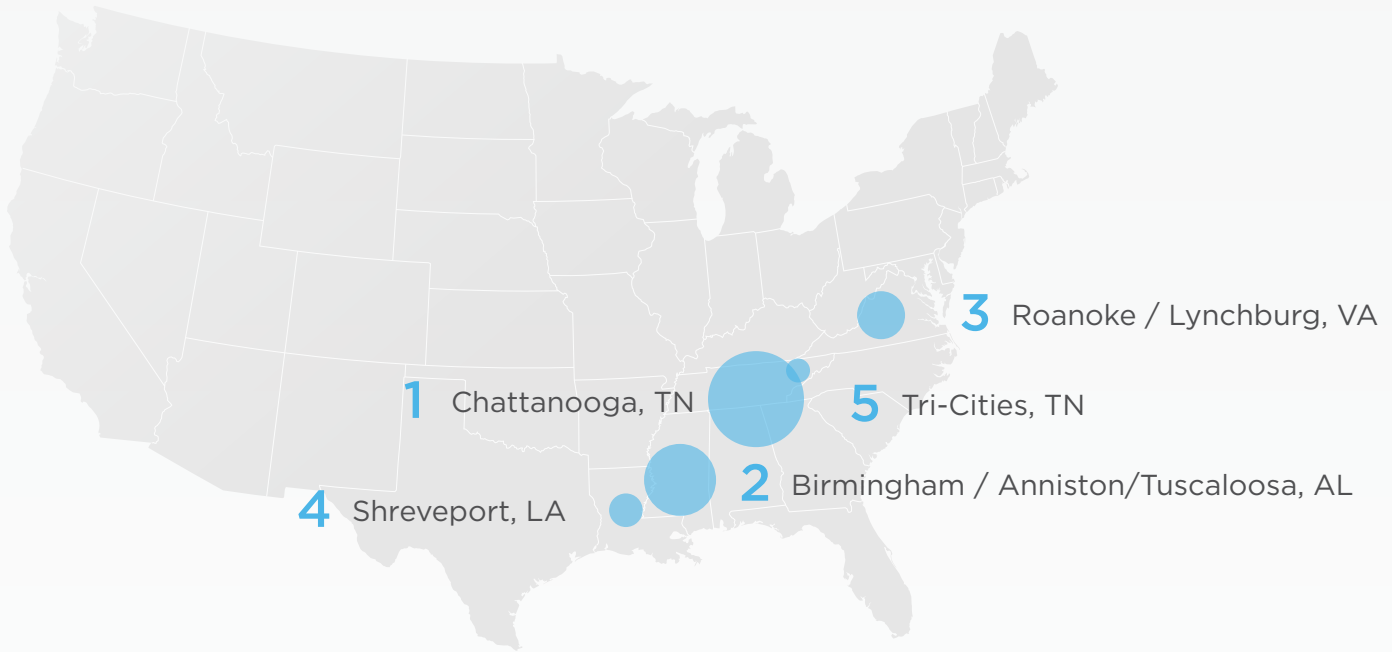

The data reported in this table are based upon telephone and online interviews with nationwide random samples of 65,064 adults conducted over a ten year period, ending in August 2015. The maximum margin of sampling error associated with the aggregate sample is ±0.4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Respondents who report reading the Bible within the past seven days and who agree strongly in the accuracy of the Bible are classified as "Bible Minded."
