## Questions about Galatians

1.	How were certain people trying to make the Galatians turn away from the good news about Christ? (1.7; 3.1-14; 5.1-15;
	6.12-15) Why was this a problem?

- 2. Both Peter and Paul were respected leaders in the early church. Describe in your own words the conflict Paul had with Peter (2.11-21). What did Peter do that upset Paul? What did Paul say to "correct" Peter? How do leaders in churches today handle conflicts and differences of opinion?
- 3. What do you think Paul means when he says that "Christ rescued us from the Law's curse"? (3.13) What does this mean for the way Christians are to live?
- 4. Paul says that "Christ has set us free!" (5.1) In what ways are Christians free? What does this kind of freedom include? What, if anything, are its limits?
- 5. What does Paul mean when he says, "you will harvest what you plant"? (6.7) Think about your life a year from now...five years from now. How do the decisions you make today affect your future?
- 6. Compare the list in 5.19-21 with the list in 5.22,23. Where do the items in each list come from? What does Paul mean when he says that "God's Spirit has given us life"? (5.25)
